The department of Hindi started in the year 1965 when the college came into existence. In that time Dr. P. Subramanyam worked in the department. He was an eminent person who provided quality education in this department till he retired in December 2000. At present the department is taken care of by Shri A. Showkath Ali, an eminent teacher. He is pursuing M.Phil through M.K. In the department, majority of the students or women come from economically backward areas of Rayalaseema region. The pass percentage of the students is around 92%. The percentage of the students who reached university is around 3%. These students are encouraged to develop creative writing to develop skills in Hindi language. The faculty regularly conducts seminars, group discussions and quiz programmes.
