The program inspired the students and they are filled with Nationality and pride of our country. The program concluded with National Antham.

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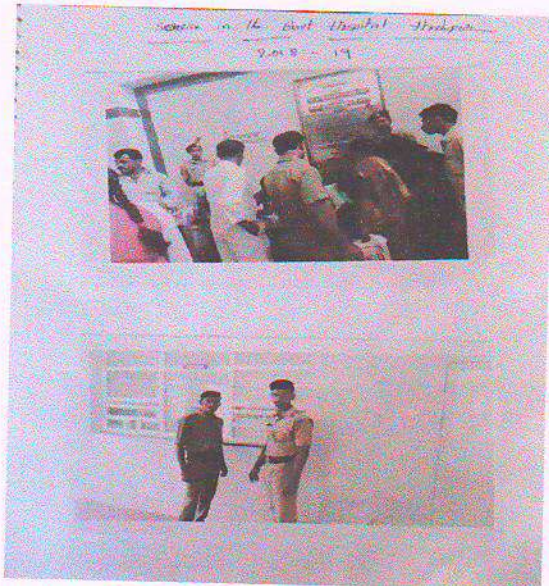

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A REPORT ON "OPEN DEFECTION FREE PROGRAMME."

Lack of cleanliness and hygiene in the rural areas is the major cause of concern to the Government. As a part of "JanmabhoomitMaaVooru" programme, initiated by the State Government to discourage the rural people for open defecation, the NSS unit of the College arranged a special awareness camp from 2-1-2018 to 11-1-2018 in Pulakunta village. The volunteers visited every house and hut in the village, conversed with the villagers and urged them to put an end to open defecation. Banners were displayed and slogans were raised to create awareness about the need to end open defecation. The Government Officials concerned, provided helping hand to the volunteers in their efforts. The villagers were explained about the ill-effects of open defecation. They were told about the health hazards caused by the open defecation. They requested the villagers to utilize the Government schemes which would help them to build personal toilets with the financial assistance extended by the Government. A meeting was organized on the final day of the camp and all the villagers were sensitized about the pros and cons of open defecation by the Principal and other speakers.
